- The Formcentric studio app does now provide an overview across all existing forms and a way to quickly open and edit these forms in the Formcentric editor.
- Contents may now be selected with the newly added content-picker, directly inside the Formcentric editor.

- The Captcha element can now be configured to use *Friendly Captcha* and *Google reCAPTCHA* as alternatives to the integrated *JCaptcha*. More information can be found in the developer and user manual.
- It is now possible to define validators at the page level. In addition to the existing JavaScript validator, a field count validator is now available, allowing validation of the minimum and/or maximum number of fields that must be filled on a page.
- Bugfix: Double opt-in now also works for forms embedded on a page with a URL fragment.
- Bugfix: The utility-class *TaglibFunctions* is once again exposed to the FreeMarker environment.
- Bugfix: The new credit card number validator is now selectable.
- Bugfix: In the recipient fields of the email action, list fields and comma-separated values with email addresses can now also be referenced.
- Bugfix: Restores the functionality of the "more than" and "less than" conditions.
- Bugfix: In the message of the email action, fields that are not part of the selected form elements can now also be referenced.
- Bugfix: The RegEx validator can now validate leading and trailing spaces in the entered value, as these are no longer automatically removed.

- The recent change from two to three numbers in the CoreMedia Content Cloud versions forces us to adapt, by appending another number to our respective Formcentric versions. This change is reflected in the versions starting with this release.
- Resolves an issue that occurred in Formcentric Analytics, if custom error messages on validators exceeded 100 characters.

- Update to Formcentric Analytics 4.3.5. **Attention!** The use of Formcentric Analytics 4.3 requires that a migration to at least version 4.1.4 has been applied beforehand.

- Adds a new validator for credit card numbers.
- The validation now once again allows more than one Email-, PDF-, Webhook- and Redirect-Action in a form.
- Fixes an error related to file attachments in the Webhook Action.
- Fixes an encoding error that could occur in the FreeMarker templates and the FreeMarker MailBodyRenderer.
- Update to Formcentric Analytics 4.3.4. **Attention!** The use of Formcentric Analytics 4.3 requires that a migration to at least version 4.1.4 has been applied beforehand.
- The integrated Formcentric Core version has been updated to version 26.

Version 2401.3.0

- Breaking: As part of the conversion to Java 17 that took place in the CoreMedia Workspace, this was also implemented for the Formcentric Extension.
- Breaking: As part of the migrations of Spring XML configurations to JavaConfig, this migration has also been applied to the configurations provided by the Formcentric extension. Existing changes and adaptations in the XML config files must be migrated manually.
- Breaking: The registration and mapping of Actions, RestServices, Validators and MailBodyRenderers has been changed and simplified. It is no longer necessary to manually configure mappings, instead the affected components do need to provide their mapping value themselves. The related interfaces have been extended accordingly. Additionally, the components must be registered in the Spring context, more related information are found in the developer manual.
- Breaking: With this release, an inconsistent behavior between the headless application and the CAE integration is eliminated. In the summary and in the email action, the form elements to be displayed or sent must now be explicitly selected. An empty selection no longer results in all elements being automatically displayed or sent.
- This release provides four new datasources, that each provides values in 6 languages (en, de, fr, it, es, ru): country names, years, months und days. The existing datasources *Laender* and *Countries* have been removed and are being supplied by the new datasource country names, existing form definitions are still compatible.

- This release provides the Formcentric Analytics servers (Backend and Reporting) as an app workspace to be directly integrated into the CoreMedia Content Cloud workspace. More information are found inside the developer manual.
- A new conversion tool now makes it easier for you to migrate from Webforms forms to Formcentric forms. It allows you to transfer all forms in the CoreMedia Repository without having to manually open and convert each form in CoreMedia Studio.

Download the conversion tool from the Formcentric Maven repository by executing the following command line in the console:

```
mvn dependency:copy \
-Dartifact=com.formcentric.coremedia:formcentric-migration:LATEST:zip \
-DoutputDirectory=.
```

- **Important** A new licence is required from version *2210.1.0-rc-2* onwards.
- (Potentially) breaking: The layout element now behaves in the same way as the fieldset element: elements that are to be assigned to the layout must now be assigned directly as child elements in the layout.
- The Formcentric Editor now responds to an expired Studio session with a login screen.
- The Formcentric Editor now opens forms that cannot be edited in a “read-only” mode.
- The webhook action is now correctly validated in the Editor.
- The integrated Formcentric Core version has been updated to version 12.

- **Important** A new licence is required from version *2210.1.0-rc-2* onwards.
- Adds the Formcentric Headless Server as an app workspace for optional integration into the CMCC Workspace. Alongside existing sample code, more information about integrating and modifying/extending the new component can be found in the Developer Manual.
- Adds a new webhook action. For more information, please see the Developer/User Manual.
- Requires the configuration of the Formcentric licence in the studio-server extension.
- Unifies the configuration of Formcentric Extensions for the headless-/studio-server.
- The integrated Formcentric Core version has been updated to version 9.
- Update to Formcentric Analytics 4.0.0-rc1. This release requires the use of Solr in connection with Formcentric Analytics. For more information, please see the manuals for the corresponding Analytics releases. As part of this release, various classes from the *com.monday.webforms.backend.** package have been relocated to *com.formcentric.backend.**.

- **Important** A new licence is required from version *2210.1.0-rc-2* onwards.
- Enables the configuration of the licence for the Formcentric headless-server extension as a classpath resource like the CAE extension.
- Enables the configuration of the prefix used by the Studio API in the Formcentric app.
- Resolves an error when updating calculated values if these were hidden.

- Resolves an error that caused the deletion of uploaded files if input was made in the form with the Enter key.
- Replaces the blueimp-file-upload dependency in the Formcentric Frontend brick by the @formcentric/jquery-file-upload dependency.
- The integrated Formcentric Core version has been updated to version 8.

Known issues:

Version 2210.1.0-rc-2

- **Important** Due to a change in the licence key, this release requires a new Formcentric licence, which can be obtained in the usual ways.
- Introduces a new extension for the Headless Server. This extends the GraphQL scheme with forms in preparation for the Formcentric Headless component. Use requires the configuration of the Formcentric licence on the Headless Server.
- The configuration for the Editor can now also be stored as a global settings document in the content. For more information, please see the Migration Guide.
- Labels for the Editor can now be overwritten and extended in the *formeditor_*_custom.json* files.
- The node model is now located in the *com.formcentric.model.xml.** package. As a result, any existing template paths must be adjusted or relocated.
- Resolves errors when building the Studio integration on Windows.
- Update to Formcentric Core 7 (formerly: Webforms Core).
- Update to Formcentric Editor 2.0.4.

Version 2210.1.0-rc-1

Version 2204.3.0-beta-2

This beta release is not intended for production use.

- In this version, the version scheme changes, matching the versioning for the associated/compatible CMCC versions. This means that the major and minor versions of the Formcentric version now indicate the supported CMCC release. As an example: Formcentric versions 2204.3.0 and 2204.3.12 are compatible with CMCC version 2204.3 but not with version 2201.2 or 2210.1, etc.
- In this version, various remaining classes, configuration files and packages have been renamed and refactored from webforms to Formcentric. Existing integrations must therefore be migrated accordingly. Examples:
 - The system now searches for the licence under the new name *formcentric-license.txt*. Existing licences can be reused by renaming them or configuring the path.
 - Various packages have been moved from *com.monday.webforms.** to *com.formcentric.**.
 - Constants that were previously located in *FORM* have now been moved to *BASE*.
 - The path used to store the *WebForm.*.ftl* templates has been changed from *com.monday.webforms.contentbeans* to *com.formcentric.contentbeans*.
- Removes the *CsvRestService* deactivated in the standard version. If required, this functionality can be restored with a customisation.

Version 7.0.0.CM2201-beta-1

This beta release is not intended for production use.

- Renames the extensions from *webforms* to *formcentric*.
- Renames various configuration files, Maven modules, Coremedia components, etc. to *formcentric-**.
- Introduces a completely reworked Editor for Formcentric forms. This considerably simplifies the configuration and extension of the Editor. One-off migration of existing customisations to the new Editor is required. For more information, please see the document *formcentric_migrationguide_en.pdf*.
- Renames the Frontend brick to *formcentric-coremedia-frontend*.
- Renames the FreeMarker prefix from *mwf* to *formcentric*.
- Removes the discontinued Excel action.
- Removes the discontinued parameter *SEND_HIDDEN_FIELDS* in the email action.
- Removes the discontinued parameters *ONLY_FUTURE_DATES* and *ONLY_PAST_DATES* from the date validator.
- Removes the *webforms-search* extension.
- Update to Webforms Analytics 3.3.4.

Known issues:

- The menu options “Back”, “Open on Studio tab” and “Show in Library” sometimes do not give Studio focus.
- Dragging and dropping content from Studio to the Formcentric Editor only works over a secure connection (https).
